FINANCIAL LIABILITIES

Financial terms of this association will be mutually agreed upon and decided by both the parties based on cost on project to project basis, first agreed and decided prior to launching such project.

PERIOD AND APPLICABILITY

Unless terminated earlier as per the provision herein contained, this agreement shall be valid for an initial period of 05 (five) years from the date of signing this MOU. Subsequently, this agreement may be renewed for such further term or terms as may be mutually agreed upon.

TERMINATION

This agreement is valid till terminated by either party under mutual understanding. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time by giving ninety (90) dayswritten notice. Projects, which may be undergoing and/or have been undertaken, should be completed before termination of the agreement.

GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTES

The laws of India shall govern this agreement and any & all obligations arising out of or connected to it. Each Party submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Kolkata. Any disputes with respect to any matter or thing arising out of or relating to the agreement shall be referred to a sole arbitrator to be appointed by mutual consent. The arbitration shall be conducted at Kolkata and the language of the arbitration proceedings shall be English.

AMENDMENT:

Amendment to this agreement can be done with mutual consent of the parties signing such amendment in writing.
