Student's Week was organized at Women's Christian College from **2nd January 2022 to 7th January 2022** as per the instruction of the **Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal**. The online/virtual daily one hour program was attended everyday by students of **Semester 1** of our college. At the inauguration, **Dr. Ajanta Paul**, Hon'ble Principal of our college, addressed the students. She spoke of **the importance of youth in our society and the ways in which our students can be motivated and channelized to use their positive energy for the benefit of our society**. In this week long program, both in-house and external resource persons were invited to deliver online lectures from 3pm to 4 pm.

On **2nd January 2022**, Smt. Shomoshree Raychoudhury, Assistant Professor in Sanskrit and **Dr. Somnath Hazra**, Assistant Professor in Education, delivered lectures on the activities of NSS unit of our college. While Smt. Shomoshree Raychoudhury spoke of **the historical evolution of NSS over the years**, Dr. Somnath Hazra spoke of **the contemporary activities of NSS**. On **3rd January 2022**, Dr. Anupurba Banerjee, Senior Consultant, Silver Point High School and Managing Director, WEn Power, spoke of **'Human Values in the Machine –Learning and Digital Era'**. On **4th January 2022**, Shri Rohan Mondol and Saurav Gharai, Office Staff, Women's Christian College, gave a description of the numerous **student scholarships** given by the Government of West Bengal which includes **Kanyashree Prakalpa, Swami Vivekananda Merit cum Means Scholarship, West Bengal Minorities Development and Finance Corporation Scholarship**.
