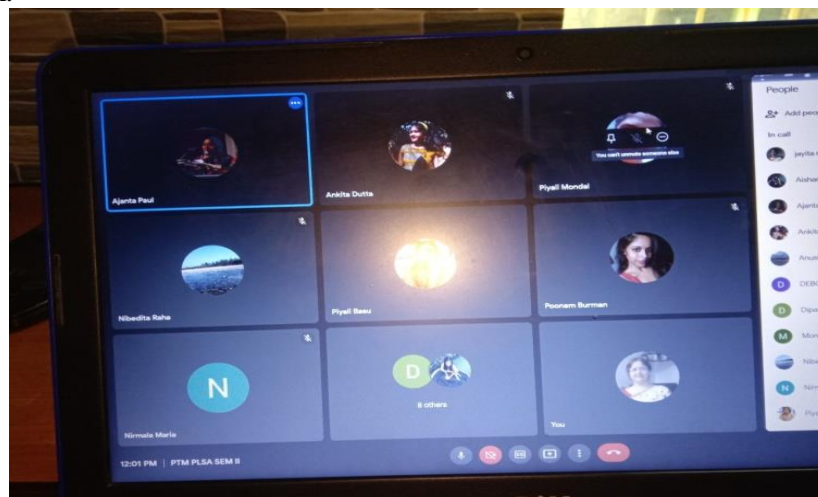
Students' Seminar:

Dr. Piyali Basu, Head, Department of Political Science, spoke on the significance of Constitution Day on 26.11.22 in the college Central Library.



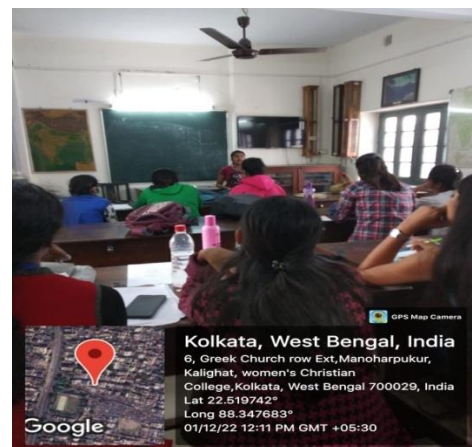

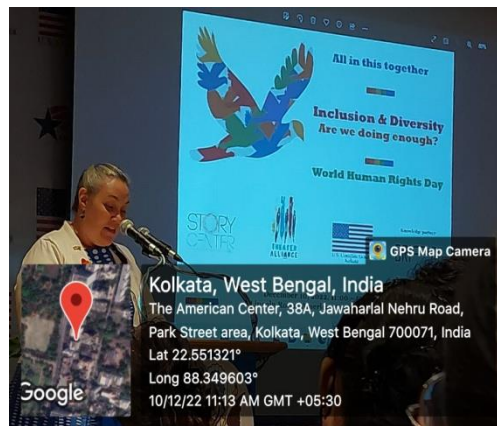
1 faculty from the Department, Dr. Nibedita Raha conducted Peer-Teaching with the semester 5 students at 10am on 5.12.22.
